Applications for the UNM CyberCorps Scholarship for Service (SFS) are now open for support starting January 2024 or later. Applicants must also apply for admission or already be admitted to the UNM MS in Computer Engineering, MS in Computer Science, or MS Cybersecurity & Business Analytics degree program.

## Financial support:

- ✓ All tuition and fees for 3 or 4 semesters of full-time study
- ✓ Stipend of \$3083.33 per month
- ✓ Professional development costs including travel to the SFS internship/job fair in Washington, DC

SFS awardees must complete a mandatory summer internship and two years of post-graduation employment in the CyberCorps. Many internships and career positions require relocation to Washington, D.C. Most career positions require a high-level security clearance (Top Secret, Q, or higher)
